Initial Boarding Release Form

Montclair Veterinary Hospital is pleased to have your pet board with us. Boarding is conditional upon your reading, understanding, and agreeing to the terms & conditions explained below. This agreement will apply to all future boarding stays. Please inquire of office personnel if there is anything you do not understand or for which you would like further clarification. Thank you for taking the time to understand our policies & procedures now, prior to leaving your pet with us.

1. DAILY CHARGES

Daily charges apply for all animals for the day they arrive regardless of arrival time, and will further accrue based on the number of nights stayed. If your pet has not been picked up by 12pm, charges for that day may be accrued. Charges will apply for every individual administration of medication, for medical services, and grooming, whether it is requested by the owner or required by the staff for the comfort or well being of the pet.

Any medications that you wish to be administered to your pet must be brought in original containers to ensure proper administration. A staff member will go over all medications with you at intake for clarification. Any medications that need to be administered that you have not provided will be refilled at your expense. (Note: Medical treatments can only be provided between 8AM and 6PM)

It is recommended that you bring a supply of your pet's regular diet to be fed while they are here in order to avoid dietary indiscretion. If you are unable to provide your pet's regular diet, we will feed an age appropriate maintenance food that will be invoiced to your account.

2. VETERINARY MEDICAL NEEDS AND FEES

If our medical staff believes a pet requires veterinary medical attention for any reason, we will schedule the pet for an examination with the attending veterinarian. All services required will be paid for by the pet owner regardless of the nature of the veterinary services – whether it is a result of signs or symptoms of contagious, infectious disease, parasitic infection or the result of an injury. Sometimes we must make decisions regarding care in your absence. We have your pet's best interest in making these decisions, and as a condition for boarding, require the authority to make decisions for you to render services for which you will be charged. (Please choose one of the following)

- I wish to be contacted first and if I am unable to be contacted, I authorize Montclair Veterinary Hospital to perform any medical treatment they see fit.
- I wish to be contacted first and if I am unable to be contacted, I authorize Montclair Veterinary Hospital to perform any medical treatment they see fit at the judgment of Dr. Enter Doctor's name here .
- I wish to be contacted first and if I am unable to be contacted, I do not authorize Montclair Veterinary Hospital to perform any medical treatments that will exceed \$500.



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3. VACCINATION AND PARASITE CONTROL POLICY

For the safety of the staff and other patients, all pets here for boarding must be current on their Rabies and FVRCP vaccinations, unless medically noted otherwise, and free of external parasites. If you are unable to provide proof of vaccination at the time of arrival, we may need to vaccinate your pet resulting in charges for an examination and any vaccinations deemed by the overseeing veterinarian. If external parasites are noted on your pet, appropriate treatment will be applied resulting in additional charges as well.

4. ABANDONMENT

All animals must be picked up within three (3) days of the specified release date. A written notice will be mailed to the address above. Five (5) days after such written notice, the animal will be considered abandoned and will be handled according to the California Abandoned Animal Act. It is understood that abandonment does not relieve me from responsibility of payment for services rendered, including the cost of boarding.

5. PERSONAL ITEMS

You are welcome to leave personal items for your pet (toys, scent items, bedding etc.). We will try our best to keep track of these items, however, we cannot guarantee its return. Montclair Veterinary Hospital will not be held liable for lost or damaged personal items left with your pet while boarding.

6. GUARANTEE

We make every effort to provide a safe, secure and healthy environment for your pet. We cannot, however, make a guarantee that your pet will not be exposed to contagious or infectious disease, or that your pet cannot escape or injure himself. Montclair Veterinary Hospital agrees to provide the best environment & care we are able to give. We want your pet to love us, like your pet loves you!
